SUBJECT: Director of Education Role and Job Description

POLICY STATEMENT

The Director of Education, as Chief Executive Officer, is accountable to the Board acting as a corporate body. The Board will instruct the Director of Education through written policies, or resolutions, thereby delegating interpretation and implementation to the Director of Education.

As the Board's official link to the operating organization, the Director of Education's performance will be considered to be synonymous with the Catholic perspective of the operational performance as a total.

Consequently, the Director of Education's job contributions can be stated as performance in only two areas:

1. organizational accomplishment of the provisions of Board policies on *Expected Outcomes/Purposes*.
2. organizational operation within the boundaries of prudence and ethics established in the Education Act, Board Bylaws and policies on *Executive Limitations*.


