Greater Sudbury is 3,627 square kilometers in area, making it the geographically largest municipality in Ontario and second largest in Canada. Greater Sudbury is considered a city of lakes, containing 330 lakes and the largest lake contained within a city, Lake Wahnapiatae.

**Description of Position**

The Speech Language Pathologist (SLP) provides assessment and treatment of swallowing and communication disorders for students with a variety of medical diagnoses and physical challenges. The SLP facilitates the academic success of students through assessments, screenings, monitoring and programming throughout the Board. The SLP is responsible for the overall implementation of speech and language services to those students experiencing speech and/or language difficulties to achieve success in an academic setting. He/she is also the deaf and hard of hearing contact person.
